

Investigator for Exceptions Management

Investigator is the go-to exceptions management solution for the FDA's Enhanced Supply Chain Security requirement, a 2023 mandate under the Drug Supply Chain Security Act (DSCSA). It manages the errors and failures that arise from new DSCSA transactions including EPCIS and VRS. Without Investigator, supply chain exceptions that are not resolved in a timely manner present severe compliance and business risks:

- Compliance gaps – FDA's Enhanced Security requirement
- Issues and errors in the supply chain – EPCIS and VRS exceptions
- Overwhelming workload – error detection and resolution are complex and resource intensive

FDA DSCSA Enhanced Supply Chain Security

The DSCSA requires product tracing information at the package level for every trade and product verification at package level for every saleable returned drug product in 2023. The EPCIS 1.2 standard has been widely adopted by the pharmaceutical industry for product tracing information and Verification Router Service (VRS) for product verification for DSCSA implementation. To stay current and compliant, a pharmaceutical company needs the technology stack of EPCIS, VRS, and Investigator.

Why Investigator?

As pharma companies begin to add EPCIS and VRS into their daily operations, data errors are inevitable.

- The average EPCIS error rate is 36% in the Production system.¹
- The average VRS failure rate is 44% in the Production system.²

Under these two categories, there are a great many different scenarios that each require different procedures, corrections, and sometimes even different personnel to manage.

By 2023, buyers will be prohibited from accepting shipments with any EPCIS errors. If EPCIS exceptions go unaddressed today, they are sure to wreak havoc on the 2023 supply chain with shipment delays, quarantines, and returns.

How does Investigator manage EPCIS exceptions?

Investigator for EPCIS is built with hundreds of GS1 data rules and complex business algorithms. It detects EPCIS errors in seconds and sends real-time alerts to the sender. The sender then follows a live hyperlink in the alert to view the errors and start their resolution process. The result is a successful EPCIS data file exchange that keeps your product moving through the supply chain.

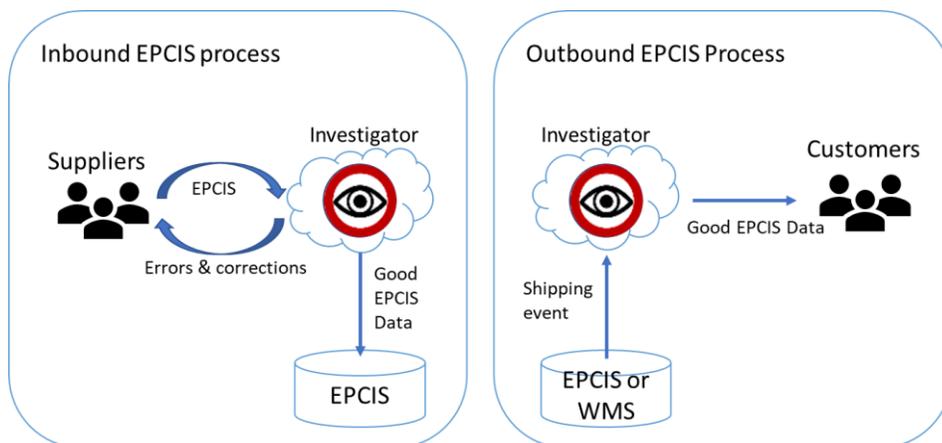
